♦ **What about my kids?**

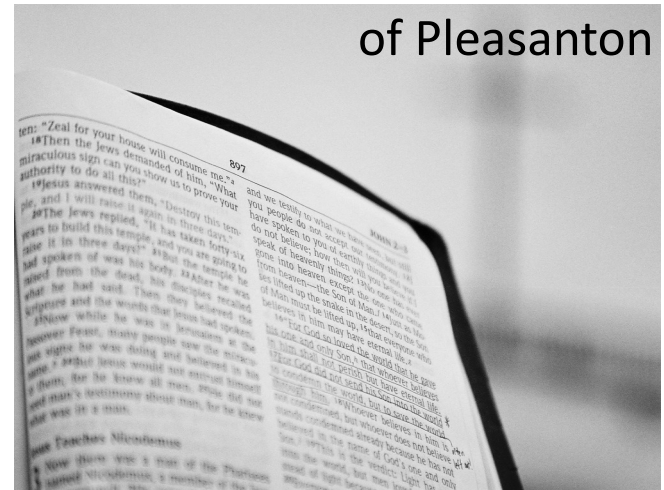
We have a nursery and children's church. Of course you can keep your kids with you if you prefer. (And don't forget about Sunday school!)
